Most endorsements are made by union delegates to Labor Assembly Committees on Political Education (COPE), the political arm of the AFL-CIO. The Texas Gulf Coast Area Labor Federation COPE makes endorsements in districts that cross one or more labor assembly's or CLC's jurisdiction. The Texas AFL-CIO COPE makes endorsements in statewide and Congressional races.

Candidates must win support from 2/3 of COPE delegates to obtain an endorsement. A Dual Endorsement results when two candidates both muster 2/3 of delegates' support. A No Action decision means that no candidate in a race mustered 2/3 support, allowing affiliated unions to support the candidate of their choice.
